Instructions:

Luminaries are sold by the dozen and consist of a white paper bag and white plumber candle. Purchase enough to place one on each sidewalk seam

Turn down top 2" of bag to outside

Place approx 2" of sand, bird seed, cat litter..etc to hold candle upright. Can also staple candle to bottom of bag, then use a smaller amount of sand to hold upright.

Position luminaries on sidewalk and light at 5:30

*There will not be a rain date! If weather is inclement (bags igniting or pouring rain), feel free to save them for next year or light them Christmas Eve.
